Between 2017 and 2018, a total of 15,558 students (permanent residents, Canadian citizens, international students, and other temporary residents) were enrolled in District 44 North Vancouver. Of these students, **942 were English Language Learners (ELL), representing 6.1% of the student body**. Among both ELL and non-ELL students, the top five unofficial languages spoken at home were Persian (849), Korean (476), Tagalog (405), Spanish (329), and Mandarin (280).
